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GROWTH

But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. 2 Peter 3:18.

When we study the teachings of Jesus and the apostles we find many references to growth, this is not in order to obtain salvation BUT is our response to all the Jesus has done for us and provided for us as we learn to work out our salvation. Below are some examples.

- ❖ Build yourself up in your most holy faith. Jude: 20.
- ❖ Make every effort to add to your faith. 2 Peter 1:5
- ❖ Continue to work out your salvation. Philippians 2:12/13.
- ❖ Devoted themselves to the apostles teaching, fellowship, communion and prayer. Acts 2:42
- ❖ Equipped, built up, unity in faith, fullness of Christ, maturity, grows. Ephesians 4:11-16
- ❖ Do your best to present yourself to God as one who is approved and correctly handles the Word of God. 2 Timothy 2:15
- ❖ Hold firmly to the Word. 1 Corinthians 15:2
- * Faithfulness Hebrews 3:5/6.
- ❖ Always give yourself to the work of the Lord. 1 Corinthians 15:58
- ❖ Stand firm, let nothing move you. 1 Corinthians 15:58

To cover all the areas mentioned in the above list would make a book, so I have decided to take just four areas of growth that will give us a good foundation to build on.

- ❖ Grow in our knowledge of Jesus Christ especially what He is doing now and who we are in Him.
- ❖ Develop lifestyle of dependency on the Holy Spirit
- Grow in grace so that it impacts those around us.
- Develop a lifestyle of faith that impacts our world.

JESUS CHRIST

What others said about Jesus Christ in John's gospel

- John the Baptist: Lamb of God, Baptiser in Holy Spirit. 1:29-34.
- Nathaniel: Son of God, Holy one of Israel 1:47-51
- Peter: Holy one of God 6:66-69
- Martha: The Christ, The Son of God 11:21-27
- Thomas: My Lord, My God 20:24-29
- John (the author of the book): The Christ The Son of God 20:30/32
- Jesus (to Pilate): I am a King; my kingdom is not of this world 18:33-40

What Jesus did

In all of the gospels there are records of all Jesus did and taught – in John's gospel there is only recorded 7 miracles (or signs) – all remarkable and giving clear signs of his divinity (John 3:2, 20:30-31)

- Turning water into wine John 2:1-11
- Healing nobleman's son John 4:43-54
- Healing man at pool (sick for 38 years) John 5:1-15
- Feeding 5000 with 5 loaves and 2 fish John 6:1-14
- Walking on water John 6:16-21
- Giving sight to man blind from birth John 9:1-41
- Raising Lazarus from the dead John 11:1-44

Description of the King

- Jesus is the Christ Acts 2:36
- Jesus is the Son of the Living God Matthew 16:16, 17:5
- Jesus Christ is the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world John 1:29
- Jesus Christ Baptises us with the Holy Spirit, Power and Fire Matthew 3:11-12
- Jesus Christ is the Source of Faith Hebrews 12:2
- Jesus Christ is the Head of the Church Ephesians 2:19-23
- Jesus Christ is the King of Kings and Lord of Lords Revelation 19:16.

Resurrected and Glorified Christ

- Appeared in heaven once to take away sin by sacrifice of Himself. He will appear a second time to bring salvation to those who are waiting for Him. Hebrews 9:24-28
- God exalted Him to the highest place and has been given the name that is above every name Philippians 2:9-11
- He has been given all authority in heaven and on earth Matthew 28:18
- Christ has been seated in the heavenly realms and we are also with Him Ephesians 2:4-7.
- Opened up the way for us to come to the Father Ephesians 2:18
- Interceding for us Hebrews 7:23-25. Romans 8:34.
- Seated in heaven, waiting for His enemies to be made His footstool. Hebrews 10:11-14.

In Christ and Christ in us

From Romans to Revelation there are over 250 references to who we are "In Christ" and who "Christ is in us" Read you Bible to find them and then pray them in and speak them over yourself they are life changing.

GOD THE HOLY SPIRIT

His divine power has given us everything we need for life and godliness through our knowledge of him who called us by his own glory and goodness. 2 Peter1:3

The key to moving in and receiving from the Holy Spirit is relational (2 Corinthians 13:14).

It is important to have a clear biblical base for our experience with the Holy Spirit

WHO IS THE HOLY SPIRIT?

The Holy Spirit is the divine power of God – God cannot be God without revealing and releasing His divine power.

The Holy Spirit is equal with God the Father and God the Son. Scripture clearly teaches their equality and also shows their different functions and personalities

- all were involved in creation (Genesis 1:1-2 and John 1:1-3)
- all were involved in our salvation (John 3:16, Hebrews 9:14)
- all are involved in our being saved (2 Thessalonians 2:13)
- all will be involved in our eternal salvation (2 Corinthians 1:21-22, 5:1-10)

The following scriptures help us understand more clearly who He is.

- 1. The presence of God (Psalm 51:11, 1 Corinthians 3:16-17)
- 2. The power of God (Acts 1:8, Luke 24:49)
- 3. To be respected by all (Matthew 12:22-32, Mark 3:28-29)
- 4. He was and is involved in our salvation (Hebrews 9:14)
- 5. He is the hallmark of the local Church (Ephesians 2:20-22)

It is important that all believers understand and co-operate with the Holy Spirit's ministry.

GRACE

For if, by the trespass of the one man, death reigned through that one man, how much more will those who receive God's abundant provision of grace and of the gift of righteousness reign in life through the one man, Jesus Christ. Romans 5:17

GRACE. God has made available to us all the blessings, resources and favour of Heaven that by rights are Christ's but now are freely available to anyone who repents of their sin and puts their faith in Christ and his atoning death – it is the unmerited favour of God.

Grace is greater than sin Romans 6:1

Grace reigns through righteousness to bring eternal life Romans 5:21

Grace releases different gifts to the body of Christ Romans 12:6

The church is built by God's grace through His ministry gifts

Grace works: FOR YOU (salvation)

IN YOU (sanctification)

THROUGH YOU (service) 1 Corinthians 15:10.

Teaches us to say no to ungodliness Titus 2:11-13

Established in the grace of God Hebrews 13:9

NEED TO CONTINUE IN THE GRACE OF GOD Acts 13:43

FAITH

And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to Him must believe that He exists and that He rewards those who earnestly seek Him. Hebrews 11:6

We need to see that there are 3 main aspects to faith in the context of what we are teaching.

• Faith is relational (it is who you know)

It must always be rooted in and come from our relationship with Christ.

Jesus is our source of Faith Hebrews 12:2 Galatians 2:17-21

God gives us a measure/deposit of Faith Romans 12:3

God's Word develops our Faith Romans 10:17

The Holy Spirit gives us the gift of Faith 1 Corinthians 12:9-14

The Holy Spirit produces in us the fruit of Faith Galatians 5:22

The Holy Spirit is the Spirit of Faith 2 Corinthians 4:13

God wants us to be strong in Faith Romans 4:18-25

We must get a fresh understanding and come into the full experience of what it means that "The Just (Righteous one) shall live by faith." Habakkuk 2:4, Hebrews 10:37-38

• Faith is Factual (it is what you know)

In order to have a faith rooted in Christ (who is the Living Word) it must be based on scripture which is God's written Word.

FAITH is not just wishful thinking or a positive attitude

It is knowing what God has said

It is believing what God has said

It is saying what God has said (in spite of circumstances)

It is acting on what God has said

FAITH is having complete confidence in what God has said He will do

• Faith is Functional (it is what you do)

Having faith that comes from Christ, rooted in the Word of God, we can now live and act like God intended and we see what we can do by faith.

CONFLICT

Matthew 28:18-20

¹⁸ Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. ¹⁹ Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptising them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

Areas of conflict:

- 1. PERSONAL: Internal and external, natural and or spiritual
- 2. CHURCH: People, leadership, doctrine, practice and or spiritual attack
- 3. WOLRD: Home, workplace could be natural or spiritual

Major spiritual areas to deal with:

- 1. WORLD: a system or government that is independent or opposed to God
- 2. FLESH: sinful nature, our human nature without God
- 3. THE DEVIL: Satan, father of lies, deceiver and accuser of God's people

KEYS FOR VICTORY

THE CROSS: through it we crucify our sinful nature and die to the world's principles and power. Galatians 5:24, Colossians 2:20

THE WORD: through it we are transformed to think God's way.

Colossians 3:9-10, Ephesians 4:22-24

FAITH: through it we overcome, living in victory. Hebrews 12:2,

Ephesians 6:16, 1 John 5:3-5.

CLOTHING

Garment of Praise: Isaiah 61:3.

Garments of Salvation Isaiah 61:10

Robe of Righteousness Isaiah 61:10

Clothe yourself with Strength Isaiah 52:1

Clothe yourself with The Lord Jesus Christ Romans 13:14. Galatians 3:27.

Clothe yourself with Compassion, Kindness, Humility, Gentleness and Patience Colossians 3:12; 1 Peter 5:5.

Clothed with the Power of the Holy Spirit. Luke 24:49.

ARMOUR

In Ephesians 6:10-20 we find a description of the warfare that every Christian and Church are involved in not with people but with principalities and powers that are under the control of the devil and his forces

- Finally be strong in the Lord and His mighty power
- Put on the full armour of God
- Take your stand against the devil's schemes

The armour needs to be worn at all time both individually and the church

- Belt of Truth• Breastplate of Righteousness
- Shoes of Peace
- · Shield of Faith
- Helmet of Salvation
- Sword of the Spirit

All these pieces of armour are a description of who Jesus Christ is.

Let us look at some of the weapons we have to use when in spiritual battle

- Name of Jesus
- Blood of Jesus
- Word of God
- Prayer, Praise and Worship
- Holy Spirit and His gifts
- Faith

CONCLUSION

Jesus used many parables when teaching about the Kingdom of God. Mark 4:1-25 The Parable of the Sower is all about growth, please take time to read, study and apply to your situation. Jesus points out seven enemies that stop the Word from growing and producing a harvest. They are listed below.

- 1. Satan comes to snatch the Word sown in our heart (v15)
- 2. Trouble or
- 3. Persecution come because of the Word they quickly fall away (17)
- 4. Worries of this life
- 5. Deceitfulness of wealth
- 6. Desire for other things choke the word making it unfruitful (v19)
- 7. Myself (v24/5)
